

**STIPULATION FOR TEMPORARY ORDER
WITHOUT MINOR CHILDREN
FORMS FA-4127VA AND FA-4127VB**

This document allows the parties in an action for a divorce or legal separation without minor children to agree on how various issues such as asset allocation, debt payments, maintenance payments, and similar matters will be handled while the action is pending. **Both** parties must sign the Stipulation (FA-4127VA) form. If the parties are not in agreement, you may wish to file an Order to Show Cause and Affidavit for Temporary Order (FA-4129VA and FA-4129VB) instead.

The Stipulation and Temporary Order is a two-part form, so please be sure to complete and submit both FA-4127VA (Stipulation) and FA-4127VB (Temporary Order).

After completing the applicable sections of the forms, mail or take **the original and two copies** of the completed and signed documents to the Court Commissioner Center, Room 2000, 215 S. Hamilton Street, Madison, WI 53703. **There is no filing fee.** You will need to **include a self-addressed, stamped envelope** for the Court's use in returning the signed forms to you.

A Court Commissioner will review the stipulation. If approved, the Court Commissioner will sign the temporary order, retain a copy for the Court, and return the original documents and a copy to the parties (if copies and a self-addressed, stamped envelope were provided).
