

## 4 TYPES OF FILINGS FOR

### JUVENILE GUARDIANSHIP OF THE PERSON

- 1) Full Guardianship gives the guardian full custody and control until age 18. Court may grant child support for guardian and/or visitation for parents.
- 2) Limited Guardianship authorizes specific powers and authorities as requested/ordered for a specific period of time as requested/ordered.
- 3) Temporary Guardianship grants authorities as reasonably related to the need for a guardian. Stays in effect for 180 days and can be extended for another 180 days upon a showing of good cause.
- 4) Emergency Guardianship will grant authority to a guardian immediately upon the showing of a need for immediate appointment due to an emergent situation. Powers of guardian will be reasonably related to need for guardian and may be granted for up to 60 days but may not be extended.

Emergency Guardianships need to be filed separately and must specify an actual emergency for the child.
